The Cross Country squad had seven meets this year and was unable to capture a team first place, but the competition was the toughest in years. Dick Huling and Wayne Walker paced the Crusader squad getting 76 and 97 total team position points respectively, the least being the best. NNC took second in the Idaho Collegiate Cross Country Championship to highlight the season. There were seven men who ran their way to a letter: Marvin Belzer, Rob Edwards, Dick Huling, Randy Rodes, Sid Sever, Wayne Walker, and Bob Wilson. These men with the elongated gait were skillfully and dedicatedly coached by Paul Taylor. Good job, men!!















The Crusader Roundball team finished the season with a rather disappointing 11-16 record. Ray Rumpel, voted NAIA Honorable Mention All-American, led the team in 10 categories, and was second in four categories. Senior Dick Luhn led the team in four categories and placed second in eight. Ray paced the team in field goal attempts (439), field goals made (196), percentage (446), free-throw attempts (89), free-throws made (62), offensive rebounds (252), total rebounds (399), total points (454), and scoring average (16.8). Dick Luhn led the team in turnovers (85), recoveries (85), assists (83), and fouls (103). Jay Nutting led the team in free-throw percentage (.765). Paul Ellerbrook's contribution the last half was very valuable, as it gave the Crusaders a true "big man." His return next year and his obvious improvement could give NNC an admirable winning season, along with returnees Jay Nutting, Jim Page, Darl Bruner, Ray Rumpel, a mended Van Cummings, and some hot-shooting freshmen.

The 1972-73 edition of the Crusader wrestling squad completed its season with a 4 - 10 record in dual competition. They finished 3rd in the Lewis-Clark Black Mark Tournament and earned 10th spot in the District II NAIA Tournament.

Leading scorer for the season was Dennis Schilling (126 lb. classification) who garnered 58 points while he gave up only 12 points. Dennis, a freshman, received a first place in the Lewis-Clark Black Mark Tourney and a 3rd place in the District II NAIA Tournament. His individual season record was an excellent 12 wins, 4 losses, and 1 tie.

Gene Benjamin did very well in his 118 lb. class, scoring 33 points while giving up only 11. Doug Vanderpool, in the 177 lb. class scored 37 points and gave up only 25 and earned a trip to the District II NAIA Tourney. Jeff Weisen, a senior, did very well in his only year as a college wrestler, scoring 30 points and losing only 16 points to his opponent.

The win-loss record of the Crusaders deems no apologies, for the enthusiasm and ability was omni-present. Five of the losses were by one run, which could obviously have gone either way. The final record was an inappropriate 7-17.

The outstanding offensive player was senior catcher, Dave Boschker. He led the team in eight categories, including runs (20), hits (31), doubles (led the nation with 10), triples (2), home runs (3), fewest strike-outs (4), RBI's (20), and an amazing batting average of .449. He also threw out 15 would-be base stealers, which proved his defensive ability.
